DO NOT SIT ON THE EDGE OF THE SEAT, ARMRESTS OR ON THE BACKREST AS THIS COULD CAUSE THE CHAIR TO TIP OVER.

DO NOT USE THE CHAIR AS A STEP STOOL.

DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN UNATTENDED ON OR BESIDE THE CHAIR.

Assembly Instructions

Your LOUIE ELECTRIC RECLINER CHAIR has been designed in Australia by Il Tutto International Pty Ltd with safety and comfort in mind.

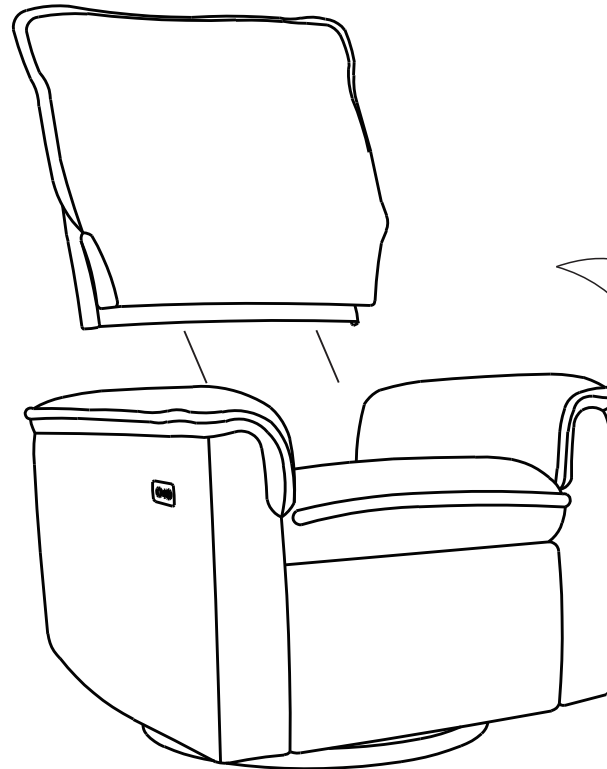
Please read all instructions carefully before and during assembly and use of this chair.

Do not allow children to play near or on the chair during assembly or use.

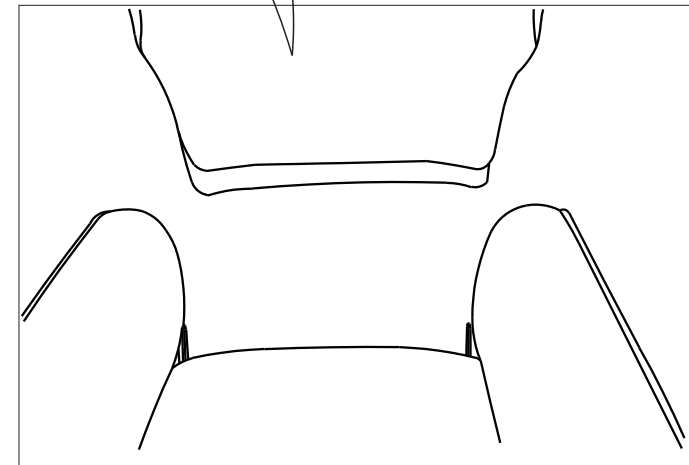
Dispose of all packaging material immediately after assembly.

We recommend 2 people assemble the chair.

Keep these instructions for future reference.



Completed assembled chair.



Push the backrest down firmly until you hear a audible clicking sound to ensure the backrest is locked firmly into place.

OPERATING THE RECLINE POSITION

1. To recline the chair and release the foot-rest, push one button on the side of the chair.

2. To retract the chair back into the upright position, push the 2nd button on the side of the chair to replace it back into the upright position.

3. USB port is located on the side of the chair for you to charge your device.



CAUTION: Do not allow children to play on this electronic chair or operate the mechanism. The leg rest folds down on closing and could possibly injure a child if they are near the folding mechanism. Do not leave children unattended on or near the chair. Always leave the chair in an upright and closed position. Keep hands and feet clear of mechanism. Only the adult occupant should operate the chair.

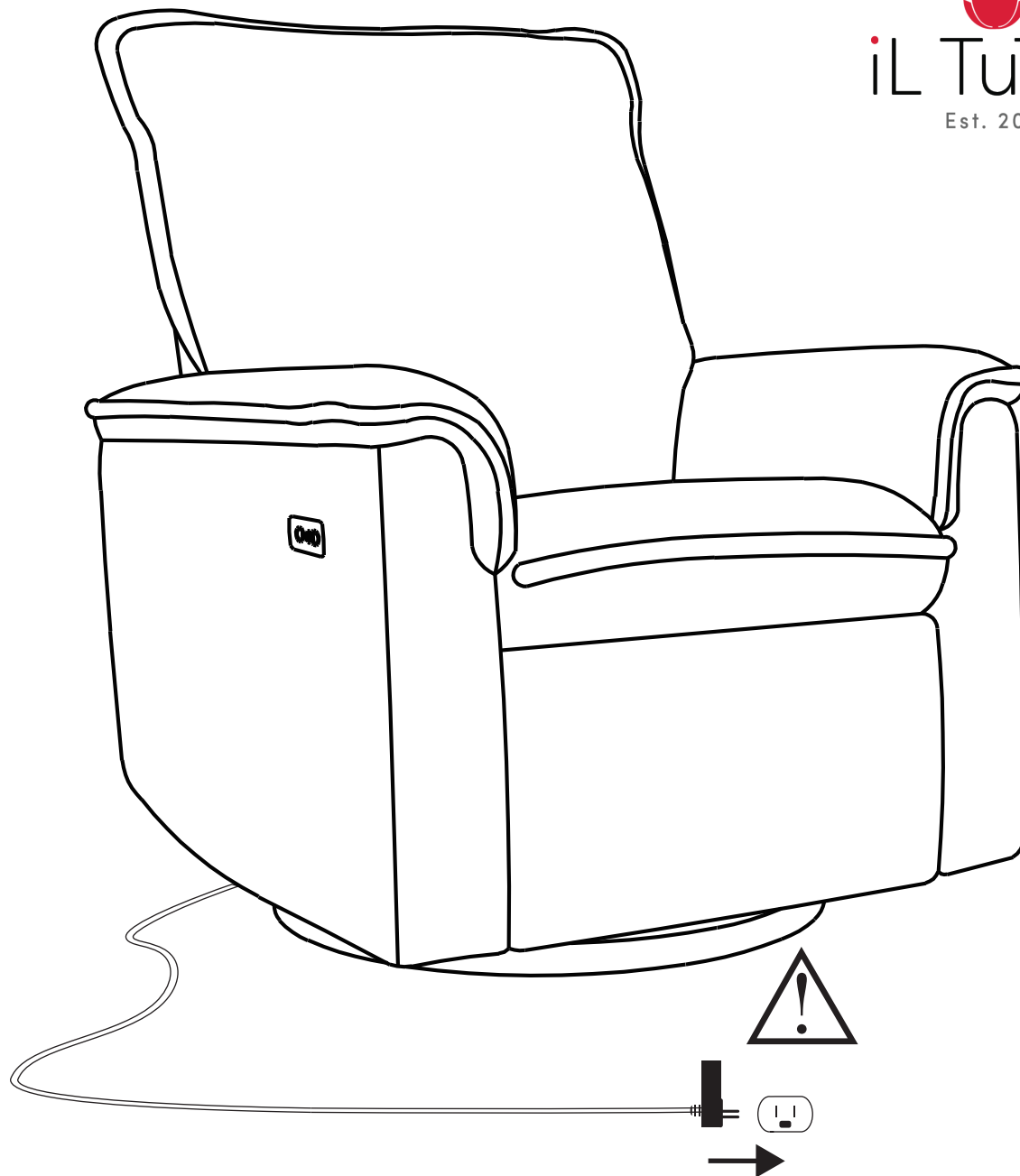
