Alfie² Bedside Bassinet Assembly Instructions



**IMPORTANT! READ CAREFULLY AND
KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.**

WARNING

Failure to follow these warnings and the instructions could result in death or serious injury.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD

Babies have suffocated:

- On pillows, comforters, and extra padding
- In gaps between a wrong-size mattress, or extra padding and product sides
- **NEVER** add soft bedding or padding.
- Use **ONLY** mattress provided by manufacturer
- Always place baby on back to sleep to reduce the risk of SIDS and suffocation.
- If a sheet is used with the mattress, use only the one provided by the product manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimension of the product mattress.
- **FALL HAZARD:** To help prevent falls:
- Do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached 9kg, whichever comes first.
- Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a product or attach strings to toys.
- Do not use if any part of the bassinet is broken, torn, or missing.

- Do not use this product without reading the instructions for use first.
- Stop using the product as soon as the child can sit or kneel or pull itself up;
- Infants have suffocated in gaps between extra padding and side of the bassinet, and on soft bedding
- Do not add a second mattress on this one, suffocation hazards
- Placing additional items in the product may cause suffocation;
- To avoid the risk of your child being strangled the attachment system to the adult's bed shall always be kept away from and out of the bassinet.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- If a sheet is used with the mattress, use only the one provided by the bassinet manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimension of the bassinet or cradle mattress.
- **WARNING:** check this product regularly before using it. Do not use if any part of the bassinet is broken, torn, or missing. Do not substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer if replacement parts or additional instructions are needed.
- Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a product or attach strings to toys.
- Infant should be placed to sleep on a firm, flat surface.
- Do not put objects or accessories in an infant's sleep environment.
- Do not place this product near a blind, cord, strap or similar item that could become wrapped around an infant's neck.
- Be aware of the risk of burning cigarettes, open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the bassinet.
- Entrapment Hazard - To prevent death from entrapment, beside sleeper must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment system.
- Before each use, check that the Bassinet is tightly secured to the adult bed and test to ensure it cannot pull away.
- Always use ALL required parts for each use mode. Check instruction manual for a list of required parts. Periodically check product for loose, damaged, or missing parts.
- Always read and follow assembly instruction for each product use mode (bedside sleeper, bassinet).
- Assemble product according to manufacturer's instructions for ANY use mode bedside sleeper as well as the bassinet modes.
- Only the bedside bed mode can put down the side bezel.
- Only use the attachment system provided by the manufacture
- This bedside sleeper is designed for use only with adult beds that are between 559mm to 673mm from floor to top of adult mattress.
- DO NOT use bedside sleeper if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact BabyRest for replacement parts and instructions. DO NOT substitute parts.
- Bedside sleepers shall never be used in an inclined position.
- The product should be placed on a horizontal floor;
- Young children should not be allowed to play unsupervised in the vicinity of the bassinet;
- The bassinet should be locked in the fixed position when the child is left unattended;
- The bedside sleeper can be used for aligned adult bed only.
- All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly and that care should be taken that no screws are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (eg. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies' dummies, etc.), which would pose a risk of strangulation;

Cleaning & Maintenance

Frame:

Wipe the metal frame with soft, clean cloth and mild soap

Mattress Cover:

Remove cover from mattress foam. Soft machine wash or hand wash with cold water. Gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tumble dry on low heat.

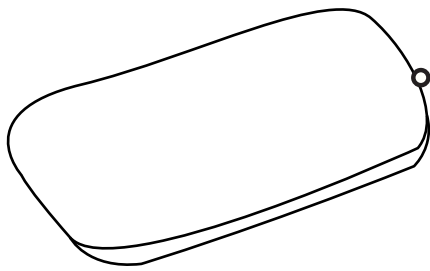
Remove Bassinet fabrics for washing

Release the guardrail section and slide the fabrics out of the rail. Slide out the bassinet fabrics from the top rail beginning from the centre post of the bassinet. Continue to remove all fabrics from the frame.

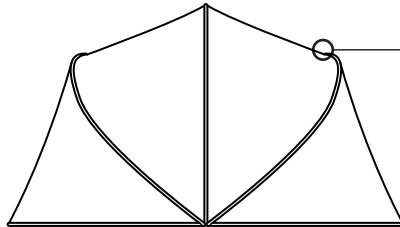
Washing instructions for bassinet fabric:

Gentle cycle with water below 40°C. Do not Dry Clean. Iron on low heat. Dry flat

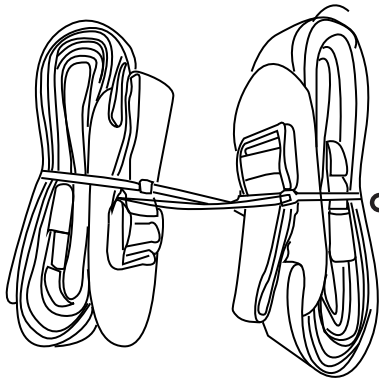

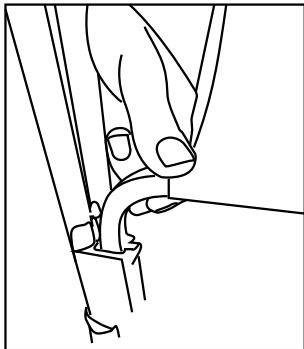
Bedside Bassinet Assembly



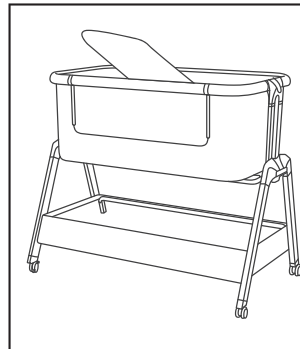
Step 1: Unfold the Bassinet as shown



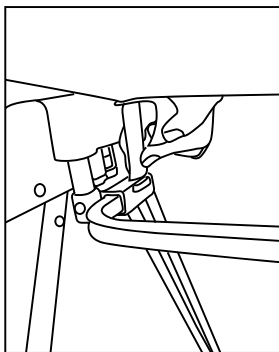
Step 2: Insert the base support bars into the plastic connection, push until it clicks. Place the bar with the L-shaped extension on the same Side as the Removeable guardrail.



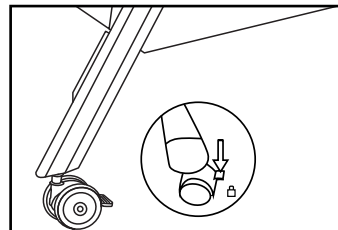
Step 3: Insert the storage basket supporting tube into the plastic fitting until you hear a "click" sound.



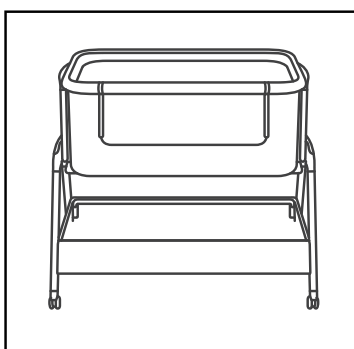
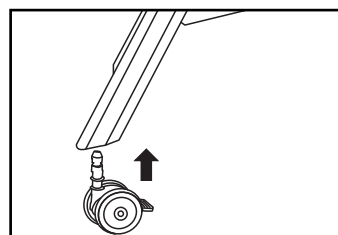
Step 4: Place the mattress inside the Bassinet and ensure it is correctly fitted



Step 5: Place the strap through the plastic hole and feed it through the D ring. Tighten to secure.

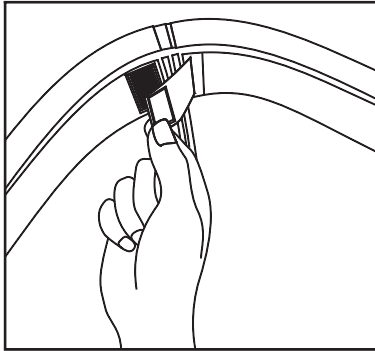


Step 6: Insert the wheels into the legs, make sure they click into place properly.

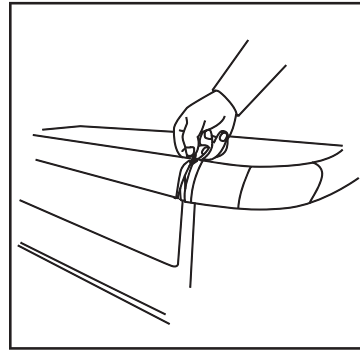


Step 7: The bassinet is now fully assembled.

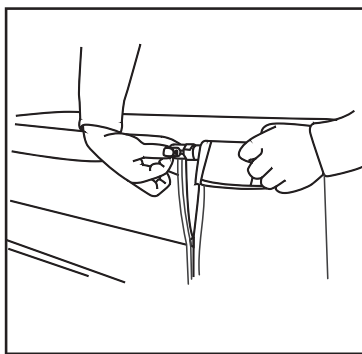
How to use Removable guardrail



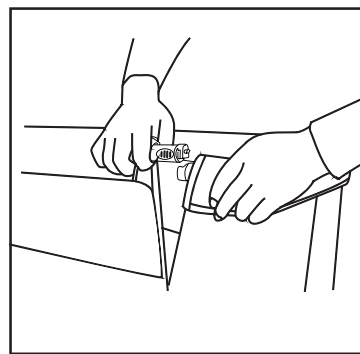
Step 1: Remove the flap to access zipper



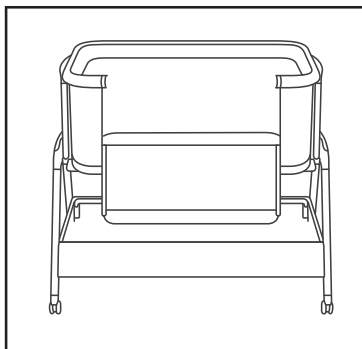
Step 2: Unzip both sides of the guard rail.



Step 3: Locate the release buttons under both ends of the guardrail on both sides, and slide inwards.



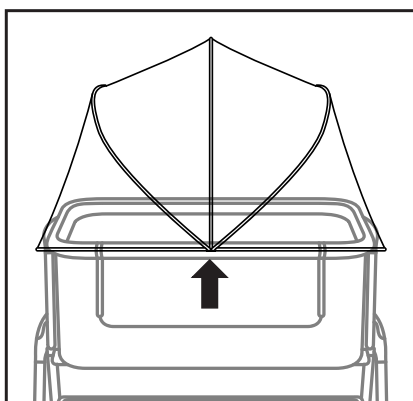
Step 4: Gently lift guardrail upwards and inwards, to release from the Top rail.



Step 5: Fold guard-rail down to outside of Bassinet as shown.

DANGER! Always completely raise the Guardrail when not attached to the adult's bed.

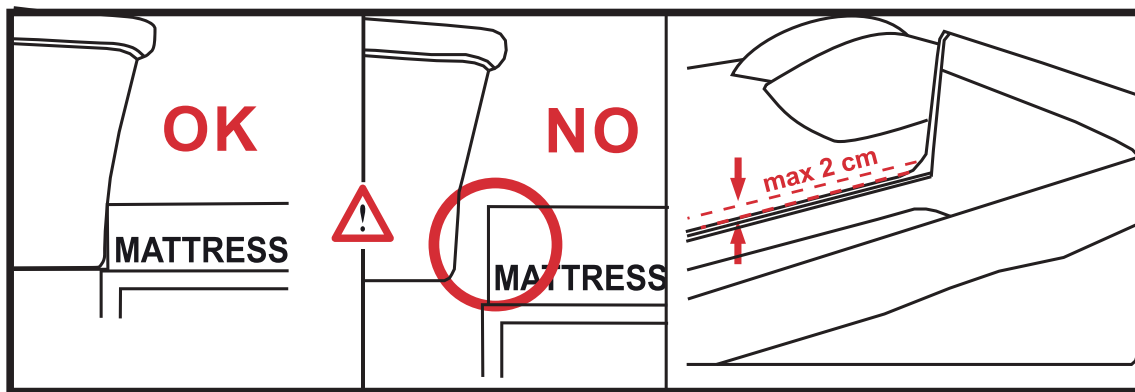
How to attach Mosquito net:



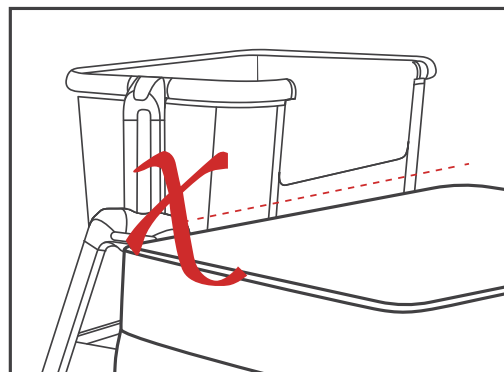
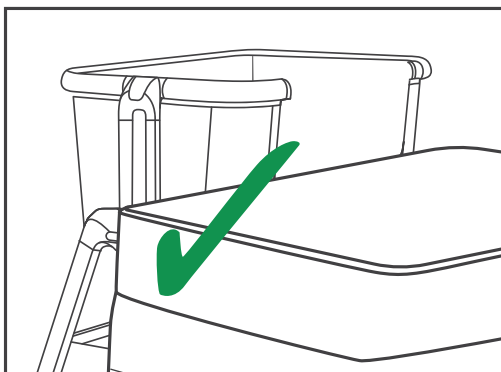
Put the mosquito net on frame and fix it with the press studs underside of the upper tubes at both sides.

WARNING

- Ensure the height of the Bassinet mattress is aligned with the height of the Adult bed mattress.
- When the removeable guardrail is dropped down, store on the outside of the bassinet and out of the babies reach.
- When fixed to an adult bed the Bassinet must be closely fitted to the bed ensuring there is no gap.



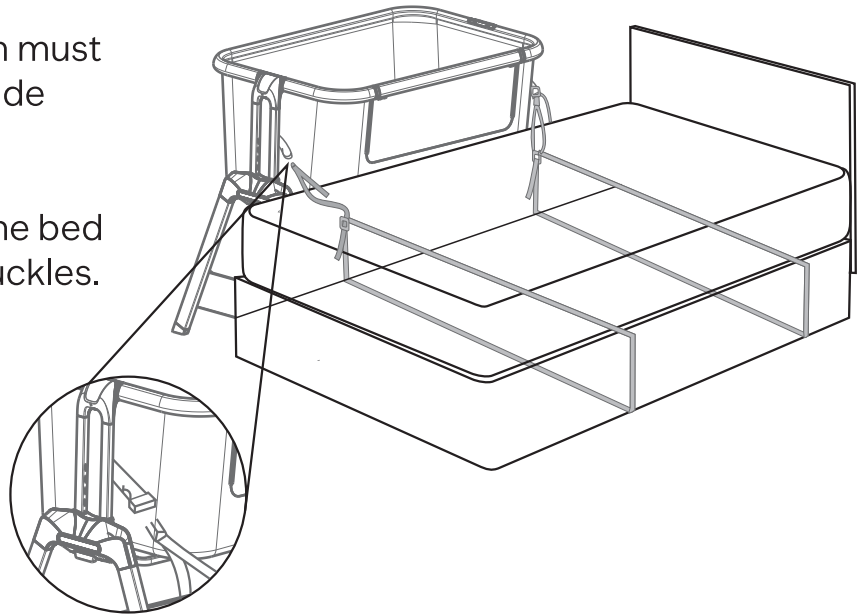
Place bedside bassinet alongside the parent's bed and with the guardrail lowered, adjust the bedside bassinet height until the top edge of the bedside bassinet's lowest side is level with or below the parent's mattress.



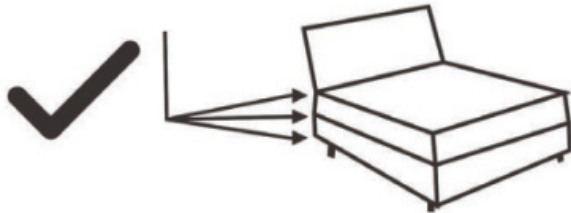
⚠ WARNING

The attachment system must **always** be used in bedside sleeper mode

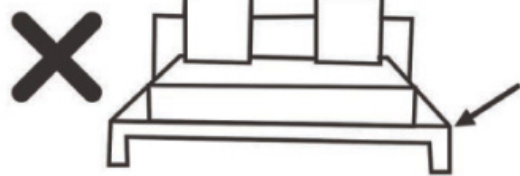
Put the strap through the bed mattress then fasten buckles.



Mattress, Box springs & Frame aligned



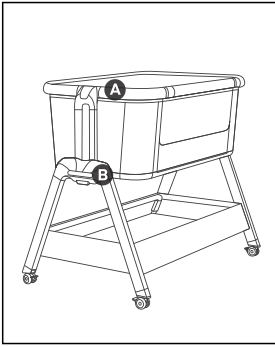
Acceptable adult bed conditions for co sleeping mode (Bed Frame In-Line)



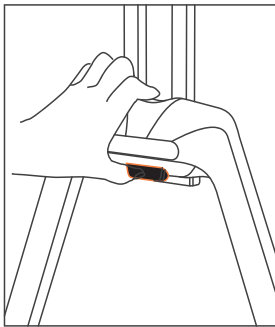
Unacceptable adult bed conditions for co sleeping mode (Bed Frame Not In-Line)

How to adjust the height

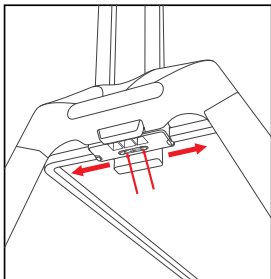


Step 1: To raise the Bassinet, hold the top rail at point A, and hold the Bassinet at point B. Lift the Bassinet to desired height, ensuring it clicks securely into place.

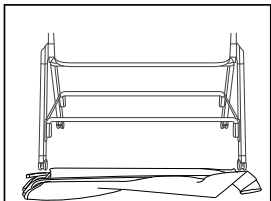


Step 2: Hold the plastic height adjustable handle on both brackets and lower down to the desired height as shown.

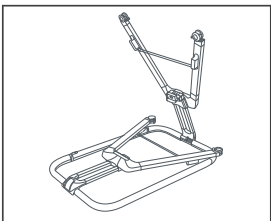
How to fold the Bedside Bassinet



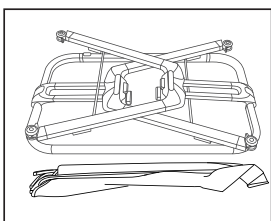
Step 1: Remove the base support bars from the bassinet bracket as shown.



Step 2: Remove the storage basket



Step 3: Fold both legs in.



Step 4: The bedside bassinet is now folded to place into storage bag as shown.

Warranty

BabyRest provides the following warranty for all genuine products purchased in Australia or New Zealand for domestic household use.

This warranty is limited to consumer buyers of the product for their personal use, personal family or household purposes. This warranty does not extend to unauthorised purchasers of the product intended for resale or for purchasers who intend to use this product for commercial use such as a childcare centre environment (unless stated explicitly for commercial use), and rental of the product to others.

Exclusions

The following are not covered by the warranty policy:

1. Defects caused by ordinary wear and tear by everyday use, natural discolouration of materials over time or by not following the cleaning & maintenance instructions
2. Damage caused by accidents, improper use, negligence, fire, contact with harmful liquids or another external cause
3. Damage caused by another product, including accessories
4. Damage by service or repair by an unofficial representative of BabyRest
5. Theft
6. Air transportation or freight damage
