Incline




The head of the child in the crib should never be lower than the body of the child.

Bedside sleepers shall never be used in an inclined position.

The incline position may only be used when the SnüzPod5 is used as a standalone crib and where the zip down wall is zipped up / closed.

Do not use the incline position during periods of sleep.

The maximum angle of the crib when in the incline position is 10 degrees.




Using in Bedside Mode (fastened to bed)

When attached to your bed, SnüzPodhas a permanent half-height wall to meet the bedside crib standard BS EN 1130:2019.

1 Follow the instructions below to fit the straps to your bed - these will be tightened later.


Use the attachment system provided. Do not use another attachment system.



- 2 Ensure the metal pole is in the correct, lower location and the zip down wall is lowered fully.
- 3 Ensure the zip down wall is tucked between the crib frame and the adult mattress.

 Leaving the metal pole in the upper location could be hazardous.

 Always retain the metal pole in the rear wall (the wall furthest away from your
- Ensure that your mattress is level with the top of the zip down wall of the crib.



5 Tighten straps to secure the crib to your bed.

Do not over tighten the strap, as this may cause the crib frame to tilt.

Ensure that the crib frame is flush with your bed frame / base.

Check the tightness of the attachment system before each use by pulling the bedside sleeper in a direction away from the adult bed.

Tuck any excess strap under your bed base, away from babies and children.

WARNING: Ensure there are no gaps between the crib and the adult's bed.

WARNING: During use, always ensure that the parents' bedding, sheets, blankets etc. do not enter or cover the inside of the crib.

can sit or kneel or pull itself up. This product is only suitable for a child who cannot sit up unaided.

WARNING: Placing additional items in the product may inside of the crib. cause suffocation.

WARNING: Do not place the product close to another product, which could present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blind/curtain cords, etc.

WARNING: Do not use the product with more than one child at a time.

WARNING: Do not use crib without the fabric bag.

WARNING: Choking hazard – keep loose screws out of reach of children.

WARNING: Keep metal poles away from babies and childrenult's bed using the straps provided only, in line with the user guide. WARNING: Be aware of the risk of burning cigarettes, spen all excess strap material and poles are kept away from babies fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the crib.

- Maximum recommended weight of child is 9KG (20lbs).
- DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, torn, damaged, or broken. Contact Shuz for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts. Only use replacement parts supplied or approved by the manufacturer.
- Do not allow pets or other children to be left unattended/ play unsupervised near the crib.
- Only use on a firm, horizontal level, and dry floor.
- The baby should be removed from the crib before any adjustment is made to the product.
- The baby should be removed from the crib/bassinet before the product is carried or moved.
- We do not recommend using sleep positioners with this product and as per the guidance of safe sleep experts, only use a firm, flat mattress recommended specifically for use with the product.
- •Once you have moved the crib using the castors, ensure the brakes are reapplied before placing the baby into the crib.

- Gaps should not be filled with pillows, blankets or other items.

- Parts require for bedside sleper mode: Frame style bed -Part R (PSP4015) Divan or solid bed base Part S (PSP4016)
- DO NOT use bedside sleeper if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken. Contact Snüz for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts

MATTRESS

WARNING: Do not use more than one mattress in the product.

• The recommended mattress size for the crib is 800mm x 440mm x 30mm thick. Always ensure that the mattress height does not exceed 30mm. The top of any mattress used should not be higher than the mark on the inside of the bassinet leg – a small notch 10mm long. You may need to move the bag aside to see this fully. Ensure the internal dimensions of the crib are no greater than 20mm larger than the length and width of your mattress.

CARING FOR YOUR SNUZPOD5

- The mattress baseboards must be positioned so that the warnings are facing downwards once the crib is put together. The crib should be locked in the fixed position when the child is left unattended Check your crib regularly. All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly and care should be taken that no screws are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies' dummies, etc.), which would pose a risk of strangulation.
 - Regularly check that the fabric bag is securely and properly attached to the crib. Before every use, ensure that the metal poles are in situ. Regularly hand tighten screws, avoiding over-tightening as this may cause cross threading and
 - damage.

 Do not dry clean. The crib can be wiped/sponged clean with a mild detergent. The fabric bag can be removed from the
 - dry, humid, or damp atmospheres.

Store away from direct heat, or away from places of extreme temperature fluctuations such as roof attics, by outside walls, or near single glazed windows.
