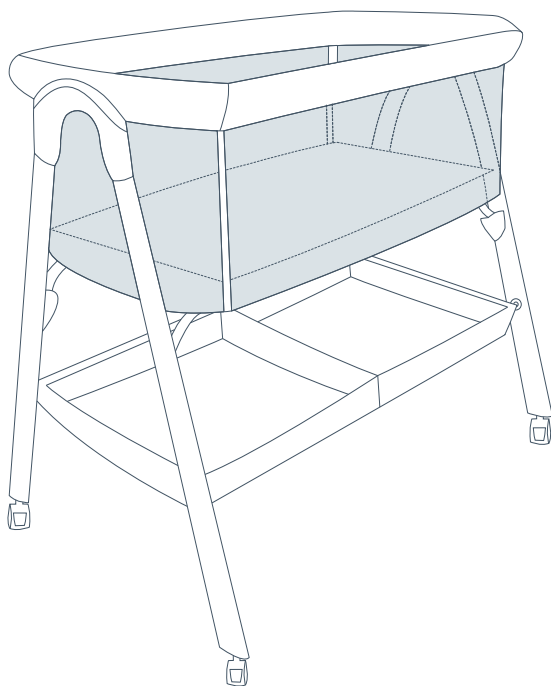

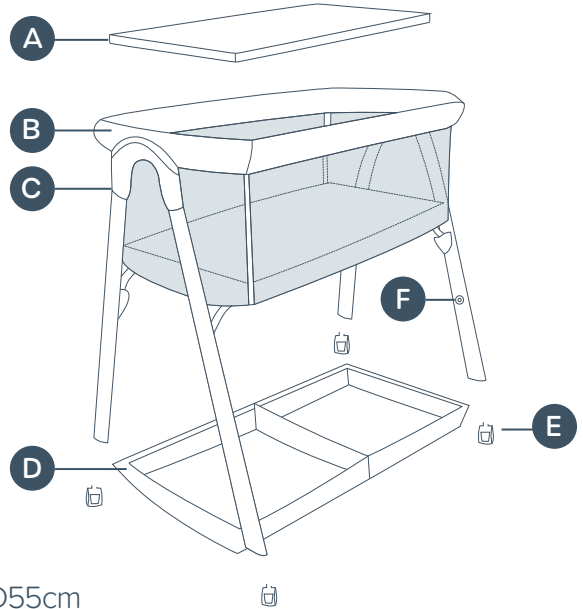
Read Carefully and Keep for Reference

Please read our assembly instructions in detail to ensure the safety features of this bassinet are not compromised.

- **Stop using the bassinet once baby can sit, roll over, kneel or pull itself up.**
- **Maximum recommended weight of child: 9kg.**
- Do not use the product if any part is broken, torn or missing.
- Ensure that the product is used on a horizontal, level floor.
- Do not move the bassinet while the baby is inside.
- Young children should not be allowed to play unsupervised in the vicinity of the bassinet.
- Do not allow pets or other children in or near the product.
- Only use the mattress specifically recommended for this product by The Sleep Store.
- The recommended mattress for this product is the mattress supplied with this bassinet and which has been tested for firmness to AS/NZS 8811.1:2013.
- Do not add another mattress on top of the mattress provided as this could cause an uneven base and/or an entrapment hazard.
- Only use replacement parts supplied or approved by The Sleep Store.
- Do not attach anything to the product which may affect its stability.
- Do not place the product near an open fire or other sources of strong heat.
- No objects or toys are to be left in the bassinet as they could increase the risk of suffocation or strangulation.
- All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly and care should be taken that no screws are loose, because a child could trap parts of their body or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for dummies), which could pose a risk of suffocation and strangulation.
- Follow the care label instructions for guidance on cleaning fabric parts.
- Dispose of all packaging safely before use and away from children.

- Fully Assembled: H77 x L89 x D55cm
- Mattress: 80x40x2cm

Materials:

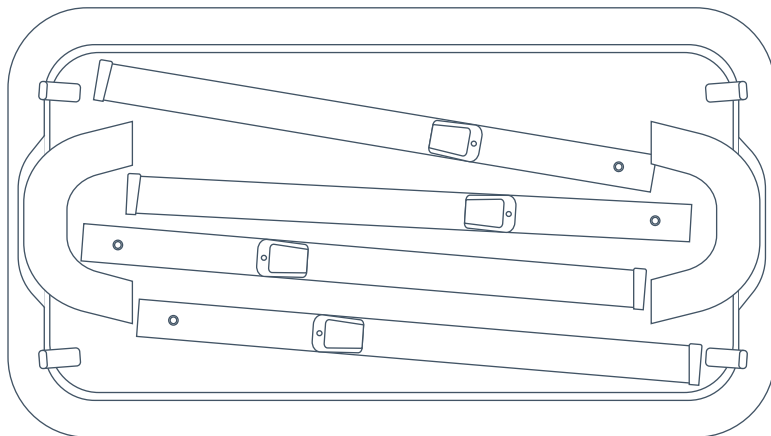
- Bassinet lining & Mattress Cover: 100% Polyester
- Mattress: Polyester Outer, Polyurethane (PU) Foam Fill.
- Frame: Steel. Joints: Polyamide 6 (PA6) and Glass Fibre (GF)
- Feet: Polypropylene (PP)

WARNING

POSITION ON FLAT LEVEL SURFACE. NEVER TILT THE BASSINET. ENSURE YOUR CHOSEN LOCATION FOR THE BASSINET IS A REASONABLE DISTANCE FROM CURTAINS, BLINDS, HEATERS, AND POWER POINTS. ALWAYS KEEP MEDICATION, STRING, ELASTIC, SMALL TOYS OR SMALL ITEMS SUCH AS MONEY OUT OF REACH FROM ANY POSITION IN THE BASSINET. STOP USING ONCE BABY CAN SIT UP OR ROLL OVER.

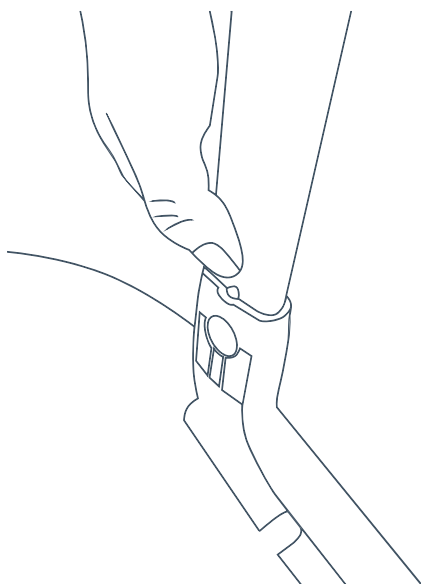
Step 1

Open the box and take out the bassinet and legs. Place it on the floor so that the underside is facing up.



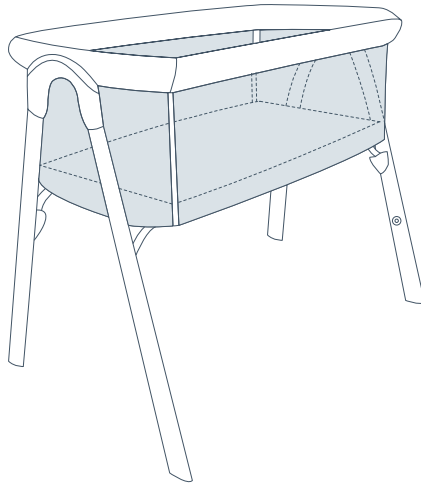
Step 2

Insert each leg into the plastic “U” shaped bracket on the bassinet’s frame. Press the stud in on the leg and “click” it into the “U” shaped bracket’s corresponding hole. Repeat for the other 3 legs.



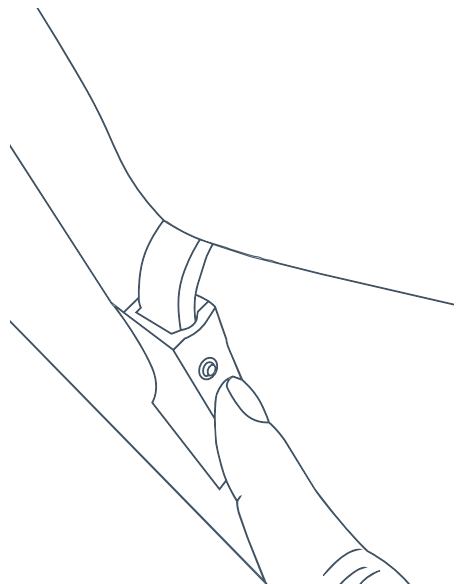
Step 3

Once all legs are clicked into place, flip the bassinet onto its feet. Place the mattress inside.



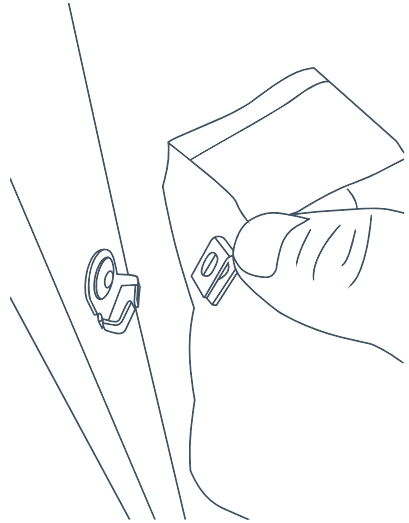
Step 4

Attach the “L” shaped brackets located on each corner of the bassinet base to each leg. Slot the bracket into the mounting point on each leg, making sure the spring mounted stud “clicks” into the corresponding hole.



Step 5

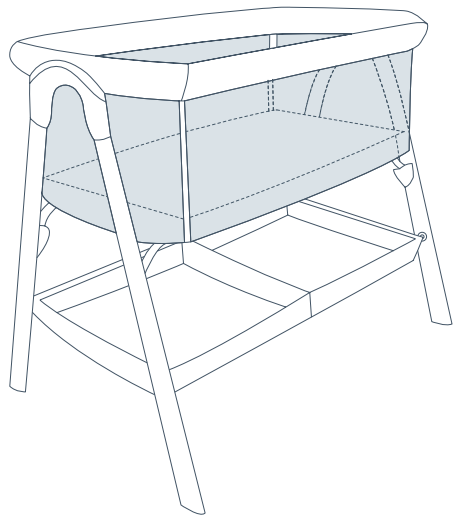
To fit the storage basket, attach each of the basket's hooks to the mounting point on each leg.



Step 6

If you do not require the bassinet to have wheels, the assembly is complete.

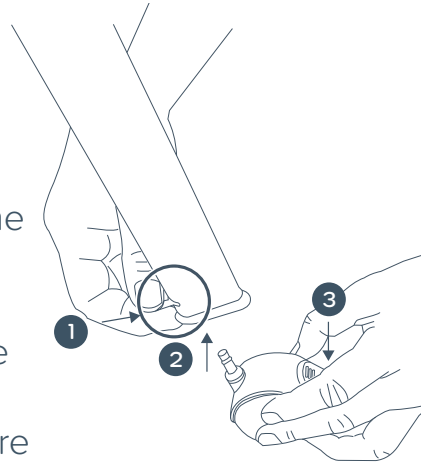

Fitting the Wheels

Follow the sequence below:

1. Flip the Bassinet onto its side.
1. Push the lock plate in and hold.
2. Align the wheel's pin towards the receiving hole in the bottom of the leg.
3. When the wheel's pin is in place release the lock plate.
4. Pull down on the wheel to ensure it is securely locked in place.



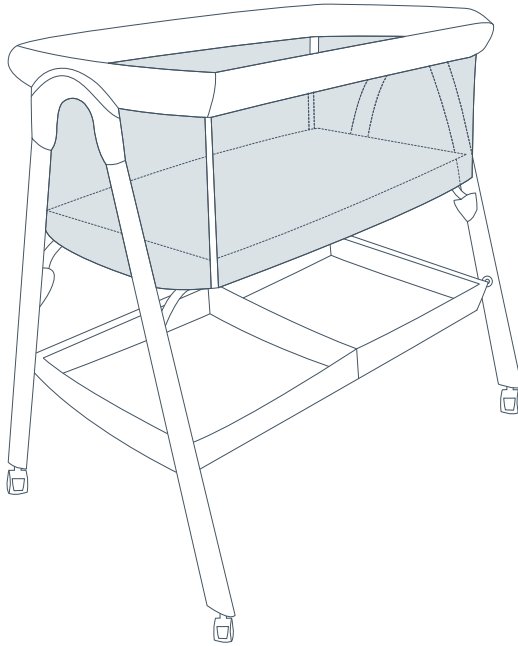
Removing the Wheels

Follow the sequence below:

1. Push the lock plate in and hold.
2. Raise the bassinet's leg and pull out the wheel.

Locking the Wheels

Press the brake lever on the wheel down to lock. Press the brake lever again to release the brake.



Maintenance & Care

All assembly fittings should be checked regularly. Your bassinet's metal frame can be cleaned by wiping with a damp cloth and drying with a soft clean cloth. Do not use abrasives, bleach, alcohol or ammonia based household polishes.

Mattress cover can be removed. Cold machine wash. Hang to dry in shade. Do not Iron. Do not tumble dry. Do not bleach. Do not dry clean. The frame's fabric insert can be spot cleaned with warm soapy water and damp cloth. Allow to dry before using again.

A mosquito net for the Mira bassinet can be purchased separately as an optional accessory from The Sleep Store.

If part of the bassinet becomes damaged, please contact The Sleep Store for the correct replacement part.
